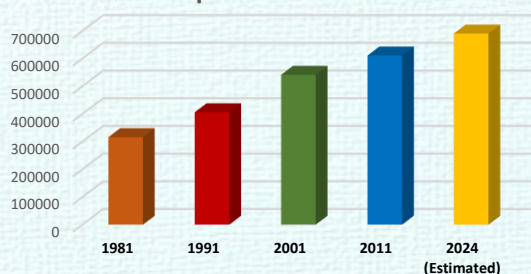


Sikkim – Area and Population

Formation of Sikkim

- Maharashtra was officially formed on **May 1, 1960**. A regional movement known as the Samyukta Maharashtra.
- The name is derived as: Maha = Great and Rakshtrika = Ratta, the tribe/dynasty of pretty chiefs (753-983) that ruled the Deccan region.



- Sikkim was originally a monarchy ruled by the Chogyal.
- Sikkim became the 22nd state of India on **May 16, 1975**, after the Indian Parliament passed the 36th Amendment to the Constitution of India, formally absorbing Sikkim into the Indian Union.
